

GYPSY CARNIVAL WITH RACHAELDAISY

Finished quilt size: 58in (148cm) x 58in (148cm)

Materials

Note: I have listed the fabrics with the colours I have used in my quilt but please feel free to get creative with whatever fabulous colours you would like to use. Pick a favourite feature fabric and let the colours from that inspire your choices.

12 fat quarters in a mix of bright coloured solids or tone on tone prints for the Prairie Points and Cornerstone backgrounds.

1 1/4yd (1.2m) of non-stick interfacing or similar coloured fabric to back the feature circles and cornerstone circles.

30in (80cm) feature fabric. Note: the circles are 14in (36cm) so, if you want to fussy cut the circles, more fabric will be required. Calculate the amount according to the print. Alternatively, you can choose four different feature fabrics.

6in (15cm) feature fabric or fabric to match for the Cornerstone circles. Extra fabric will be required if fussy cutting.

45in (115cm) of grey tone or crosshatch fabric for the block background.

20in (50cm) of spotted fabric for the sashing.

40in (102cm) of predominantly black fabric for the sashing.

To finish the quilt at home.

66in (168cm) square piece of batting.

66in (168cm) square piece of fabric for the backing.

30in (75cm) black fabric for the binding.

Tools

1yd (1m) freezer paper.

Ruler, rotary cutter and cutting mat.

Compass to draw circles (or use mine)

Thread to match prairie points and the feature fabric.

Pins and scissors,

Mini travel Iron/ironing board (optional)

Sewing machine.
